- At **Lake Laugarvatn**, we visit a historical place, **Vígða laug**, where the people of Iceland changed religion twice!
- **Brúarfoss**, the blue waterfall.
- **Gullfoss** waterfall is one of Iceland's most iconic tourist attractions.
- Geysir spring area, with the erupting geyser **Strokkur**.
- Walk around the rim of **Kerið**, an old volcanic crater and to the crater lake.
- Would you like to have an ice cream in **Hveragerði** town?
- Drive back to Reykjavík.
