For Northern Lights hunters staying in the countryside away from the light pollution, we often have a good opportunity to see them. On our tours you will get to know everything about the nature, locals, their interesting food and folklore

Tour highlights:

Day one—Borgarfjörður

- **Mosfellsbakarí**, the best bakery in Iceland, is located in the town of Mosfellsbær!
- A short hike to **Grábrók**, an old volcanic crater for the great view over the area.
- **Glanni** waterfall.
- **Deildartunguhver** is the largest hot spring in Europe. The water from this hot spring heats up two towns 45 miles away.
- An optional visit to the **Snorrastofa** museum. It is believed that Snorri Sturluson wrote down many of the Icelandic Sagas that prior to that were only oral.
- **Hraunfossar** and **Barnafoss** waterfalls are unique waterfalls and the crown jewels of Borgarfjörður.
- Hike to or towards **Glymur**, the highest waterfall in Iceland when accessible

Day two—Golden Circle

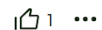
- **Steðji** (Anvil) rock with the great view over Hvalfjörður.
- **Þórufoss** waterfall, featured in the TV series **Game of Thrones**.
- **Þingvellir** (fields of Parliament) on the boundaries of the tectonic plates
- **Laugarvatn**, a geothermal-infused lake with the historical **Vígða Laug** holy pool, had a major role both times Icelanders changed religion.
- Geyser area with the erupting one, **Strokkur**, and bubbling mudpits.
- **Gullfoss**, the golden two-step waterfall, is 33 and 66 feet tall.
- **Kerið** the crater lake
- **Hveragerði**: Town of hot springs.
- Back to Reykjavík
