Day one

- The best bakery in Iceland

- Gullfoss one of Iceland's most iconic tourist attractions
- Brúarhlöð a tranquil place where the massive river runs through a narrow ravine
- Drive to our hotel on the south coast for dinner and a good night's sleep.

Day two

- Skógarfoss, a majestic waterfall with the 430 steps for our active guests
- Dyrhólaey the Door Hill drive on the island, has an amazing view of the south coast
- Reynisfjara's basalt column beach reminds us to tell you about the seals' cave.
- Vík town, church and cemetery
- Unforgettable Hike to Sólheimajökull outlet glacier
