

## Two days Reykjanes & Golden Circle

On our tours you will get to know everything about the nature, locals, their interesting food and folklore

### Tour Highlights:

#### Day one

Pickup from KEF airport or any hotel in the vicinity of Reykjavik's greater area.

#### Day one

- Visit the youngest part of Iceland, only a few hundred thousand years old. See the lava fields from recent eruptions, colorful geothermal sites with bubbling hot springs, and the vigorous waves from the Atlantic Ocean hitting the beautiful cliffs. We visit Hafnarfjörður, the town of elves and Vikings
- Seltún is a colorful geothermal area with bubbling hot springs and blue clay, a scenic view over Kleifarvatn, and the stranded ships in the coastline of Grindavík. Depending on the start time, we have lunch or snacks. The lobster soup is simply delicious!
- Reykjanestá and Valahnjúkur: Watch the beautiful rocks and the powerful Atlantic ocean waves in full action. Gunnhver is one of Iceland's biggest bubbling hot springs, where Gunna the ghost got lost! The Bridge Walk between America and Eurasia.

#### Day two

- The Golden Circle is not actually a circle! It is more of a triangle, for it is a route between the three most famous places in Iceland. The ancient Viking parliament site Thingvellir, the geyser area, and Gullfoss, Iceland's second largest waterfall. We have added many great sites, so now it is a polygon and a very large one indeed! In this tour that could actually be called Iceland 101, you will learn about the Sagas, geology, flora, and fauna, but above all, you will enjoy the beauty of it and have fun!
- Þórufoss waterfall is one of the hidden gems in Iceland. Scenes from Game of Thrones were filmed there. Þingvellir National Park to watch the tectonic plates move apart (slowly). Þingvellir is a heritage site where the parliament was established in the year 930 AD. Europa's oldest working parliament. Vígða laug (Holy pool) is a historical site for Christianity in Iceland
- In the Geysir geothermal area, watch Strokkur, the amazing spouting geyser in Haukadalur. Haukadalur church site where the good troll is buried. Gullfoss waterfall is Iceland's 2nd biggest waterfall. Saved by Sigríður from Brattholt. Faxi waterfall and Kerið crater on our way back to Reykjavik.

On this two day tour you can choose to stay anywhere between Reykjavik and Selfoss
